4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Ingestion	If swallowed do NOT induce vomiting. Immediately wash out mouth with water. Seek medical attention if irritation persists or if significant amount swallowed.
Eye	IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician.
Skin	If skin contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Do not re-use contaminated clothing until washed. Seek medical attention if symptoms persist.
Inhaled	Not normally a problem due to method of use. However if breathing is affected remove victim to fresh air and keep in a position comfortable for breathing. If problem persists seek medical attention.

Emergency Procedures	Keep unauthorized people away. Do not touch or walk through spilled material. Do not touch damaged containers or spilled material unless wearing appropriate protective clothing.
Clean Up	Recover non contaminated material and place in containers for use. Recover waste material into separate containers and dispose of through licensed waste material operator. Use water to wash off remaining small amounts of residue from surface.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling	Dispense product using scoops. Use in well ventilated area. Maintain a high standard of personal hygiene. Wash hands immediately after using product.
Storage	Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated place out of direct sunlight. Store in closed containers. Store away from incompatible materials such as strong acids.

11. TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Ingestion	Swallowing can result in nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea and abdominal pain. Can cause irritation to the mouth, oesophagus and gastrointestinal tract.
Eye	Corrosive to eyes. Will cause severe irritation and chemical burns. Contamination of eyes can result in permanent injury or blindness if not treated promptly and thoroughly.
