**4. FIRST AID MEASURES**

<b>Ingestion</b>	If swallowed do NOT induce vomiting. Immediately wash out mouth with water. Seek medical attention if irritation persists
<b>Eye</b>	If in eyes, hold eye lids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water. If irritation persists seek medical attention.
