4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Ingestion	If swallowed do NOT induce vomiting. Immediately wash out mouth with water. Seek medical attention if irritation persists
Eye	If in eyes, hold eye lids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician.
Skin	If skin contact occurs wash with plenty of soap and water. Take off contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.
Inhaled	Not normally a problem due to method of use. However if breathing is affected remove victim to fresh air. If problem persists seek medical attention.
First Aid Facilities	An eye wash and general washing facility should be available adjacent to the work area.
