

Description and Use

Motel is a premium quality laundry powder containing an activated oxygen bleach system and stain removing enzymes. It contains a low foaming surfactant system suitable for front loading machines.

Features and Benefits

Motel is a one shot product containing oxygen bleach and enzymes. This makes it very easy to use as only one product is required for most washes.

Motel contains an activated oxygen bleach. The activator makes the product more effective if the temperature drops below 70°C. It boosts the bleaching and anti-microbial effects of the oxygen bleach.

Motel has a high level of water softening agents. These enhance performance, especially in hard water areas such as South Australia.

How to Use

For front loading machines the normal dosage is 50 grams (¼ cup) per 5kg capacity in moderately hard water. This corresponds to a ¼ cup for a domestic washing machine and 1 cup per 20kg for a commercial machine.

The quantity may be reduced in soft water or if soiling is light. For heavy soiling increase dosage.

If using in a top loading washing machine, extra must be added due to the higher volume of water. Use from 1/3 to ½ cup dependant on load size and degree of soiling.

Best results are obtained at 50-60°C as the oxygen bleach requires heat to make it work efficiently.

Motel may also be used as a soaker for heavily soiled items. Use from 1/8 cup in a bucket to a cupful in a full laundry trough. If items are badly stained an oxygen bleach booster such as Dominish can be added to Motel. Do not use chlorine bleaches with Motel.

Motel can be used on all normal washable fabrics. Do not use on wool or silk.

Technical Data

Motel is an alkaline powder containing phosphates to soften water, a blend of biodegradable anionic and non-ionic detergents for effective cleaning and foam control agents. It also contains an oxygen bleach which is activated to make it work more effectively at lower temperatures.

Motel also contains a protease enzyme to help breakdown any protein stains and corrosion inhibitors to protect the machine.

Motel does not contain any caustic ingredients.
