Description and Use

Village Wash is an economy laundry powder. Suitable for top and front loading washing machines.

Features and Benefits

Village Wash is an economical powder designed to give a good wash at low cost.

Village Wash does not contain any built in bleaches, so it can be used with either chlorine or oxygen bleaches dependant on the fabric being washed.

How to Use

Village Wash may be used in domestic or commercial machines. For top loaders use from about ½ cup in a small machine to 1 cup in a large machine. Less may be used for light soiling or if water is soft.

In front loaders use ¼ cup in a domestic machine, or ¼ cup per 5kg capacity in a commercial washer.

Village Wash may be used with either chlorine or oxygen bleaches. If bleaching is required use following products.

Shor Bleach is the recommended chlorine bleach for white fabrics only. Use from ½ cup in a small top loader to 1 cup in a large one. Pre-dilute with a litre of water and do not pour directly on clothes.

Oxygen bleach should be used for any coloured fabric. Use Dominish at a rate of ¼ cup in a small top loader to ½ cup in a large one.

For front loading washers use from 1/8 cup in a domestic machine, to ½ cup per 20kg load in a commercial machine.

Do not use Village Wash or the bleaches on wool, silk or other delicate fabrics.

Technical Data

Village Wash Powder contains alkaline builders, water softening agents, corrosion inhibitors, soil suspending agents, a blend of biodegradable detergents and an optical brightener.
