Description and Use

Extra Mild is an extremely gentle cleanser for those with sensitive skin who need to wash frequently.

It can be used as a hand cleaner or all over body wash.

Features and Benefits

Extra Mild contains a blend of mild biodegradable cleansers derived from wheat and coconut oil to cleanse, plus emollients made from almond and coconut oil to protect the skin.

The pH of Extra Mild is 6. This maintains the natural pH balance of the skin, unlike soap based products that can have a pH in the range 9 – 10 which leads to degreasing of the skin.

Extra Mild is available in the Dominant Star System containers. These sealed units prevent risk of cross contamination, and are economical as only 1ml is dispensed with each pump.

How to Use

Either use through a refillable dispenser, or simply insert a new unit into the Star System dispenser.

Refillable dispensers should be washed and dried before refilling for maximum hygiene. If this is not possible, then always refill when the dispensers are empty or nearly empty.

As a hand cleanser, wet hands, apply to hands, lather, then rinse with water and dry.

As a body cleanser, apply to a sponge, lather and rinse.

Technical Details

Extra Mild is based on a blend of naturally derived cleansers derived from coconut oil and wheat.

It has a pH of 6 to maintain the natural pH balance of the skin.

The cleansers in Extra Mild are all classified as biodegradable.

Safety

Extra Mild has a pH of 6 and so is very mild on the skin.

It is available in hygienically sealed Star System containers to prevent risk of cross contamination.
